During this school year the students of 6th year have been learning about **Picasso Art**. Due to the fact that 2017 is the 80th anniversary of the “**GUERNIKA**” painting (one of the most well-known pieces of art of this Spanish artist)

Students from 6th year have created collaborative pieces of art. In order to do so, I have prepared famous paintings from Picasso in small pieces. But, how to do it? Using an application called **POSTERAZOR**.

You only have to select the picture that you want to create and following easy instructions from **POSTERAZOR** you will get the painting in several pieces (you can decide how many pieces you want). Then, the teacher gives a piece of the painting for each student, after that, they have to build up the painting and decide the colours to be used.



As you can see in these pictures, you can do the paintings in different sizes and the result is very colourful and beautiful.
